Law allows Patients to Receive Direct Access to Physical Therapy

April 4, 2008 – *Philadelphia, PA* – For casual athletes, people with reoccurring injuries and those with acute pain, seeing a physical therapist is about to get a whole lot easier. That's because of a relatively new law that enables patients to see a licensed physical therapist for treatment without first having to obtain a prescription from a doctor.

The law, referred to as Direct Access, has been advocated by the American Physical Therapy Association, and allows patients to receive less expensive and timelier care for their injuries by removing the requirement of a doctor's prescription to see a licensed physical therapist.

“When I had painful scar tissue buildup at the top of my hamstring I didn't want to take the time to visit my doctor whom I knew would prescribe physical therapy,” said Judy Michel, a Direct Access patient at Excel Physical Therapy and Fitness. “When I discovered that I could go directly to a physical therapist without a prescription I was thrilled. Within a month I was feeling great and I am still pain free. Direct Access saved me both time and money.”

Direct Access to physical therapy has been approved in Pennsylvania since 2002, New Jersey since 2003 and Delaware since 1993.
