The 180 ft X 291 ft addition at the Giralda Farms complex in Madison, NJ consisted of a two level underground parking garage expanding the capacity of an existing garage. Concrete girders spanning up to 60 ft were utilized in order to minimize the number of columns and accommodate long spans and heavy roof loads. The concrete system chosen for this project resulted in an efficient, durable and aesthetically attractive structure that is capable of supporting heavy lateral and vertical loads associated with an underground structure. All at-grade landscaping above the expanded garage was redesigned as part of the project.

PS&S and their client will receive the award at The 45<sup>th</sup> Annual New Jersey Concrete Awards Dinner on May 8, 2008 at the Hyatt Regency in New Brunswick, NJ. The evening will be highlighted by a video presentation of the award winning projects.
